



BETÜL CAN ANATOLIAN HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY (AUP)

SCOPE

This Usage Policy has been created for the security of school students in their use of the Internet, their correct use of school Internet tools, and a culture of tolerance and respect between school and school people.

INTERNET USAGE POLICY

1- Students should respect and protect personal data of individuals while using the Internet.

2- Students should use the school Internet and school technological tools to research lessons and information. They should not use it for gaming, social media, or outside of school matters.

3-) Students should not upload programs to school Internet and technological tools themselves.

4-) Students should protect and not damage school technological equipment. They should leave the Computer Lab and Design Skill Workshop as they found it clean and tidy. When they are done with computers, laptops, they should exit their accounts and turn off the machines. Thus, they support our energy saving policy.

5-) Students must follow the rules of etiquette on the Internet. They should show the words and behaviors they wouldn't say in real life on the internet. They should be courteous and kind, both in real life and online. It shouldn't be forgotten that the students represent our school with their every behavior and word; they form our school culture.

6-) When students commit cyberbullying, they are subjected to disciplinary action in line with the rules of our school policy and, if necessary, they are punished within the scope of the law. Students are obliged to know cybercrime laws and penalties. Like every citizen, they have to obey the law.
